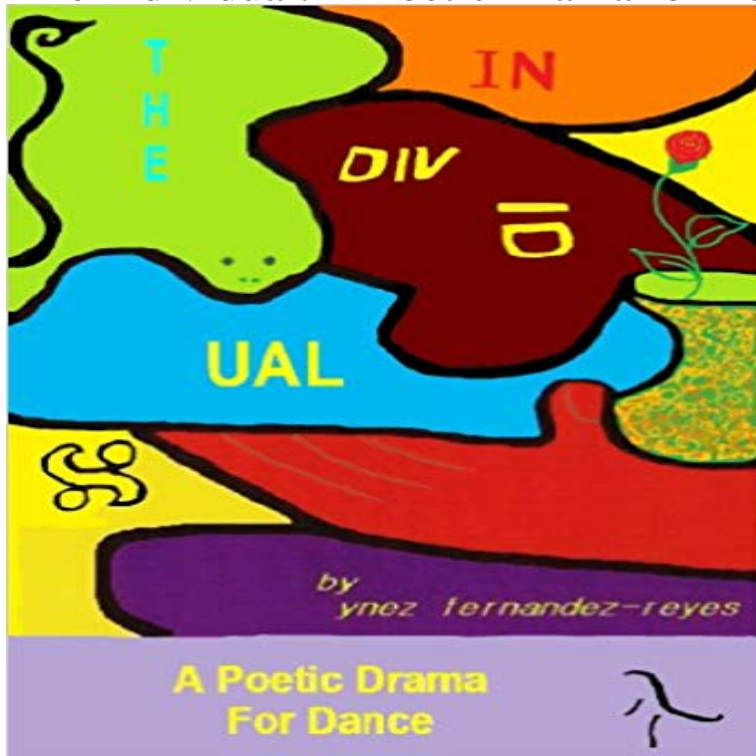


The Individual: A Poetic Drama for Dance
