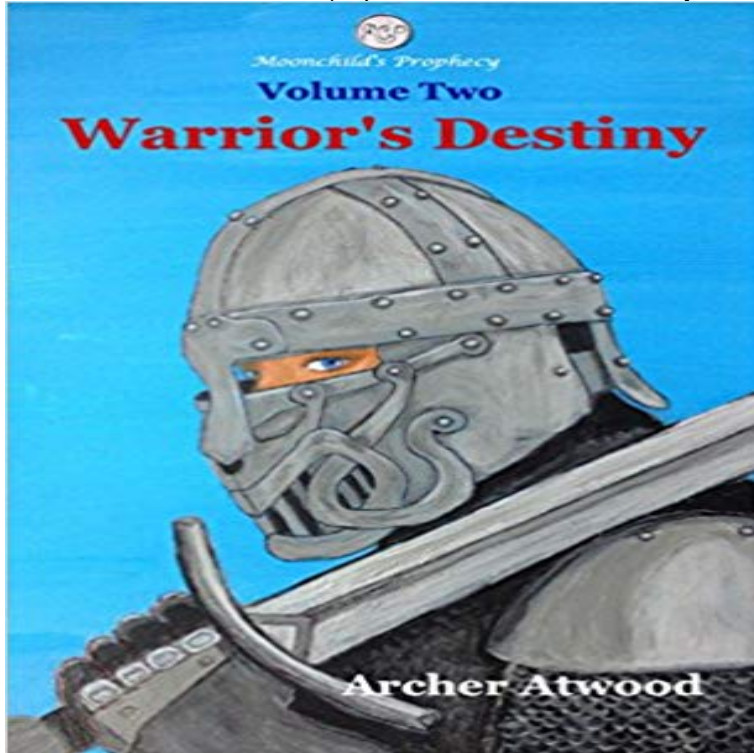


## Warriors Destiny (Moonchilds Prophecy Book 2)
