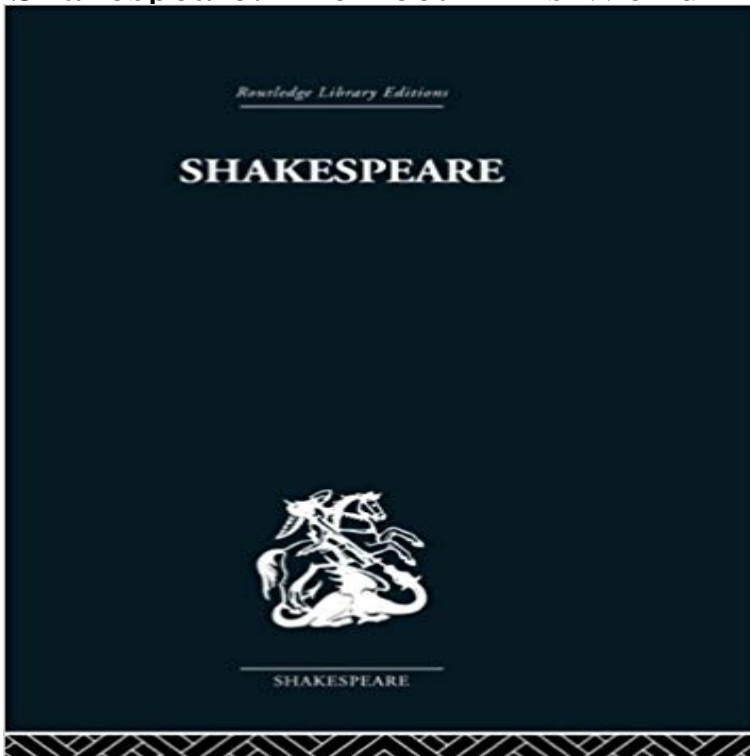


Shakespeare: The Poet in his World
