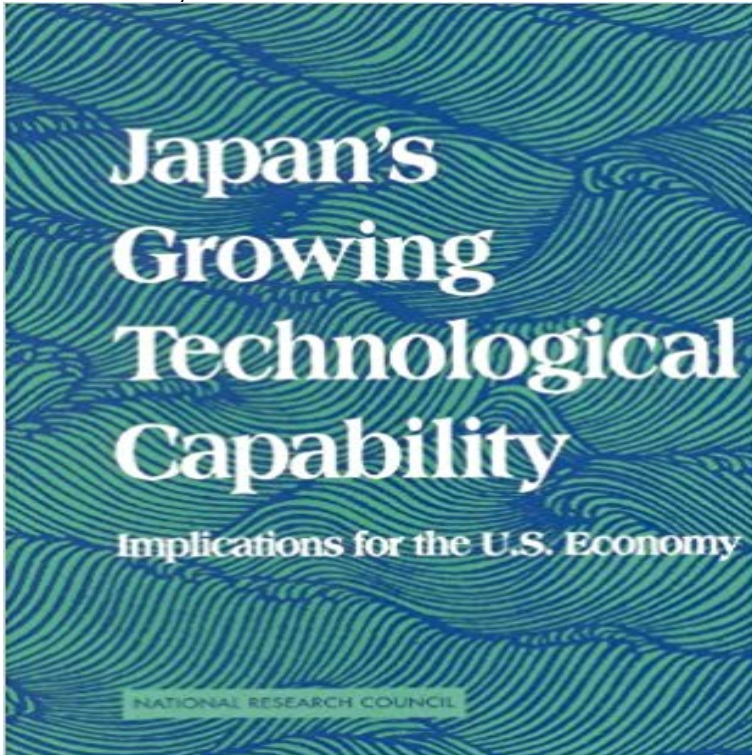


Japans Growing Technological Capability: Implications for the U.S. Economy
